The Algerian Data Protection Law becomes effective

From 11 August 2023, companies and organisations processing personal data must comply with Law 18-07 of 10 June 2018 on the protection of individuals in the processing of personal data ("**Law 18-07**").

With the recent publication by the National Authority for the Protection of Personal Data ("**ANPDP**") of all the necessary forms, <u>Law 18-07 is now fully applicable</u>.
